Coordinate closely with MEP engineers to align HVAC, lighting, and power systems with energy storage placement, ensuring seamless integration across technical and architectural domains.

Apply LEED, WELL, and other green building standards to the design of EVE's U.S. offices, R&D centers, logistics hubs, and production sites, incorporating recycled materials and low-emission finishes wherever feasible.

Integrate smart design features such as energy-efficient lighting, enhanced ventilation, and noise mitigation to promote comfort, safety, and operational efficiency in energy-centric environments.
